- Helps students develop coping skills to handle the conflicts and stress they face in life.




Mental Health Provider

- Paras work under the direct supervision of a highly qualified teacher to improve reading and math scores.
- A Para technician is utilized to support technology needs throughout the building.

Title I Paraprofessionals

- 8.3% of RSE's total Title I budget.
- Certified teachers who focus on early reading interventions.
- Voyager program in first grade.
- My Reading Coach program in second grade.



Pullout tutoring programs

- 0.3% of RSE's Title I budget is used to purchase subscription.
- Web based educational enhancement that can be used from school and home.
- Teachers are able to progress monitor student growth.
- Parents are able to access program from home to view child's performance.

Moby Max

- 1.5% of RSE's Title I budget is used to fund this activity.
- Enhances student knowledge of government, geography and history.
- Encourages parental involvement.



Fifth Grade Field Trip
