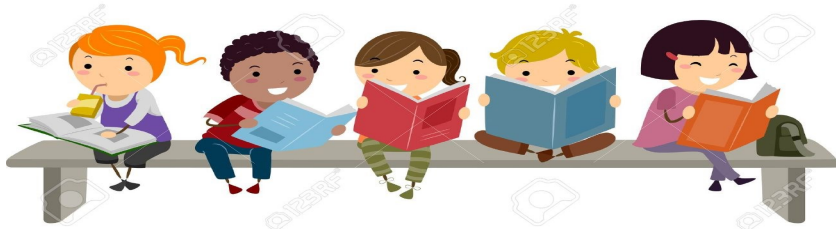

1. Your child's grades *may* be based on accommodations provided & modifications to the regular curriculum, which will be indicated in red ink on each graded paper.
2. Your child *may* be working below their current grade-level in some subjects.
3. Some grades will be based upon participation & work habits, this will also be indicated on each graded paper.
4. The comments section of your child's report card will say "Grades are based upon accommodations & modifications."

*****Special education students will receive additional progress reports indicating how he/she is performing on each IEP goal. We send these papers home with your child's report card.**
